Israel strikes Yemeni port of Hodeida

ASSOCIATED PRESS Aden Israel on Tuesday launched airstrikes on the Yemeni city of Hodeida as Iranian-backed Houthi rebels attacked air defences. The Israeli military said in an update that it struck "military infrastructure" used by the Houthis in Hodeida port.

The strikes last Wednesday followed a drone launched by the Houthis that breached Israel's multilayered air defences and slammed into a southern Israeli airport, blowing out glass windows and injuring one person. In Yemen, at least two were reported killed, including the journalist, in the strikes that hit Sanaa, including residential areas, a military headquarters and a fuel station...

In a message on his X account, the leftist leader accused the United States of seeking to "participate" in Colombian politics and looking for a "puppet president" as the country prepares for presidential elections next year.

The man, who has been identified by media as Christian Bruckner, had been serving a seven-year sentence that stemmed from his 2019 conviction for the rape of a 72-year-old American woman in Portugal.

Nepal observes national day of mourning

PRESS TRUST OF INDIA Kathmandu All Government offices and educational institutions remained closed across Nepal on Wednesday as the country observes "national day of mourning" in honour of those killed during Gen Z protests. "In memory of those who died during the protests organised by the Gen Z generation on September 8 and 9, the Government of Nepal has decided to observe a national day of mourning on Wednesday, September 17," said a statement issued by the Home Ministry on Tuesday. All Nepali embassies and missions abroad were closed, with the national flag being flown at half mast.

Pakistan Police kill three terrorists in KPK

PRESS TRUST OF INDIA Peshawar At least three terrorists were killed and four injured in two separate incidents in Pakistan's northwest Khyber Pakhtunkhwa province, police said on Wednesday. The terrorists attacked two police stations in Bannu and Karak districts on Tuesday, officials said, adding that both the attacks were successfully foiled by the police. In Bannu, terrorists first targeted the Miryan Police station and later the Mazang checkpoint, which comes under the station's jurisdiction. According to Regional Police Officer (RPO) Bannu, Sajjad Khan, the attack on Miryan police station was thwarted within 20 minutes. Later, dozens of terrorists armed with heavy weapons moved toward the Mazang checkpoint, where the gun battle lasted for about an hour. The RPO confirmed that three terrorists were killed and four injured, while their accomplices managed to carry away the dead and wounded. Three police personnel sustained minor injuries during the encounter. Meanwhile, in a separate incident, terrorists launched an assault on the Gurguri police station in Karak District. Police Officer Karak said the attackers were prevented from advancing towards the station as security forces engaged them in an exchange of fire.

On Monday, the Trump administration designated Colombia as a country that is failing to meet its international commitments to fight drug trafficking and blamed the Colombian Government for a lack of progress in the fight against the cocaine trade. The designation, known as decertification, is a stunning rebuke for a traditional ally. It comes amid a recent surge in cocaine production and fraying ties between the White House and Colombia's first leftist president. Even as the US determined that Colombia has failed to comply with international anti-narcotics obligations, the Trump administration issued a waiver of sanctions that would have triggered major aid cuts.

Germany warned Iran UN sanctions over nuclear

Germany warned Iran on Wednesday it had "yet to take the reasonable and precise actions" needed to stop the return of United Nations sanctions over its nuclear programme. The comment from the German Foreign Ministry came after a call Iran had Wednesday with France, Germany and the United Kingdom, as well as the European Union's top diplomat. Iran had no immediate comment on the call. The process, termed a "snapback" by the diplomats who negotiated it into Iran's 2015 nuclear deal with world powers, was designed to be veto-proof at the UN.
